

Transportation, roads, bridges, housing, nutrition, schools, hospitals, libraries, essential services and more










Who matters in SF?

SF COUNTS Goals

- Motivate at least 73% to self-respond
- Increase HTC participation in every area by 10-15% over 2010
- Implement a citywide call to action to motivate and mobilize all residents
