PACE– Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly

- Fully integrated Medicare and Medi-Cal health plan and provider
 - Adults 55 and over
 - Multiple health challenges
- Concentrates on the social determinants of health
- Comprehensive and coordinated delivery system with PACE centers and full range of home care services, transportation and meals
- Full risk – no deductibles





PACE is currently available in much of the Bay Area.




